
Additional Programs/Electives

- PSY 2050 and a capstone course must be taken from the student's home department.
- Continuation Standards: Students who fail to earn C in PSY 1010 or whose SLU PSY GPA is below 2.0 will be placed on probation and have a maximum of 2 consecutive semesters to resolve either or both issues. Additionally, students who fail to complete PSY 2050 within 3 consecutive semesters after declaring the major will be immediately dismissed from the program.
- \* May fulfill Learning Through Applications attribute in specific semesters. Please check attribute in Courses@SLU, or contact your advisor/mentor.
- \*\* Prereqs: 15 credits of PSY coursework and 60 earned credits.

To be certified for graduation, a student is required to...

- Complete no less than 120 credits, including 34 credits in the PSY major;
- Have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA, a 2.0 PSY GPA, and a 2.0 GPA in the minor or 2<sup>nd</sup> major;
- 3. Complete 30 of the final 36 cr. at SLU;
- Submit the on-line application for graduation at the beginning of the last semester of study.
