JOURNAL RESOURCES

<u>Academic Medicine Last Pages</u>: A collection of more than 200 one-page infographic style publications explaining key topics. Looking for a Last Page on a specific topic? <u>Request</u> to search our database!

<u>Medical Teacher Twelve Tips</u>: Series of publications offering twelve key evidence informed tips to educators on core topics.

<u>Journal of Graduate Medical Education (JGME) "New Ideas"</u>: 600 word articles describing novel local interventions of relevance to graduate medical education, with outcomes such as feasibility and acceptability.

BLOG RESOURCES

<u>CEDAR Community Blog</u>: Evidence-based, peer-reviewed blog posts on topics of relevance to educators across the teaching spectrum, authored by SLU SOM and SSM health faculty, staff, and trainees.

<u>Harvard Macy Blog</u>: One of the first peer-reviewed health professions education blogs, with more than 400 posts on a wide array of topics authored by the Harvard Macy Institute community.

<u>International Clinician-Educators Blog</u>: Promotes discussion among clinician-educators from around the world, archiving education resources with an international focus.

LISTSERV RESOURCES

<u>Dr-Ed Listserv</u>: An electronic discussion group to facilitate information and resource sharing among medical, biomedical, and health professions educators.

<u>Accreditation Preparedness and Quality Improvement Listserv</u>: Allows educators to engage in discussion related to accreditation and quality improvement, largely in the undergraduate medical education space.

APPS AND PODCAST RESOURCES

<u>Just in Time Teaching Tools App</u>: A free phone app developed at the Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell offering evidence-based, succinct teaching tips for classroom, and clinical educators.

<u>The PAPERS Podcast</u>: A podcast produced by the Unit for Teaching and Learning at Karolinska Institutet discussing the key points of a medical education article in less than 30 minutes.

PUBLISHING AND SCHOLARSHIP RESOURCES

<u>Annotated Bibliography of Journals for Educational Scholarship</u>: A compendium of journals which publish educational scholarship, developed by the AAMC-Regional Groups on Educational Affairs.

<u>MedEdMentor</u>: An "Al mentor" for health professions education research which helps identify questions and theories for research, with relevant manuscripts, theory summaries, and a quick reference glossary.
